



Admission Requirements and Selection Procedures

Complete guide to applying for the Master's program, including eligibility criteria, application procedures, and enrollment requirements.

Required Degrees for Admission

To be admitted to the Master's program, applicants must hold at least one of the following degrees (or be in the process of obtaining one by the deadline for enrollment in the Master's program):

Degree in Medicine and Surgery

Full qualification in Medicine and Surgery required

Degree in Dentistry

Full qualification in Dentistry required

Professional Registration

Registration in the relevant professional register or equivalent body in the case of foreign applicants

Alternative Qualifications

The following may also apply:

- Candidates with qualifications equivalent to those listed above, obtained under the previous university system
- Candidates with an academic qualification obtained abroad that is comparable in duration and content to those listed above

❏ The University reserves the right to admit candidates with different qualifications that are relevant to the Master's program.

Additional Requirements

Applicants must have:

Technical Requirements

Access to a computer with a broadband connection and sufficient computer skills to be able to follow the e-learning part of the course.

Language Proficiency

Knowledge of English sufficient to enable the candidate to follow the course taught in English.

Applications must be submitted via the GOMP student portal, following the instructions provided in the guide published on the Master's website, **by April 20, 2026.**

Required Documentation

In order to complete the registration process, the following documentation must be attached to the portal during the procedure:

- curriculum vitae and studies in European format, dated and signed;
- photocopy of a valid identity document;
- copy of the degree certificate
- any additional qualifications that you wish to submit for admission assessment;
- a declaration that you have read the Information Notice on the processing of personal data pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the "protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data" (hereinafter also referred to as "GDPR") provided by UniCamillus.
- photocopy of your tax code or health card (for Italian citizens and foreigners who have one);
- for candidates in possession of qualifications equivalent/equivalent to those required: a substitute declaration of certification, pursuant to Article 46, point m, of Presidential Decree No. 445 of December 28, 2000, certifying the achievement of the qualifications themselves, in accordance with current legislation;

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR APPLICANTS WITH FOREIGN QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants with foreign qualifications must submit one of the following documents by the application deadline:

Declaration of value issued by the Italian consular authority in the country of study (accompanied by a transcript of records + copy of the final diploma);

OR

CIMEA Certificate of comparability accompanied by Certificate of verification (see <https://cimea-diplome.it/>);

OR

Diploma Supplement (in the case of an European qualification) issued by the university that awarded the degree and legalized by the Italian Embassy of the country of study.

Important information about the documentation to be provided

Incomplete Documentation

Those who submit incomplete documentation will be admitted with reserve and cannot complete their enrollment until all the required documentation has been submitted.

No Reserve Enrollments

Enrolments will not be accepted with reserve due to incomplete documentation or incorrect transcription of data on the application form.

Enrollment Procedure

Following admission, candidates must follow the enrollment procedure as indicated in the relevant guide, which will be sent by email together with the notification of admission to the Master's program.

Registration Fees

The annual participation fee is **€4,400.00** (total amount for the two-year period **€8,800.00**), to be paid in four equal installments with the following deadlines:

First Installment

€2,200.00 by the deadline for enrollment, which will be communicated by UNICAMILLUS together with the notification of admission to the Master's program

Second Installment

€2,200.00 by July 31, 2026

Third Installment

€2,200.00 within 30 days of notification of passing the final exam of the 1st year of the Master's program

Payment Deadline Policy

If the candidate does not make the payment within the time frame indicated by UniCamillus in the admission notification, they will lose their place in the ranking and the list will be scrolled down until all places are completed.
